Biographical Note

Jean Hertzman is the Director for the School of Hotel, Restaurant, and Tourism Management at New Mexico State University. Previously, Hertzman worked at the William F. Harrah College of Hotel Administration at the University of Nevada, Las Vegas (UNLV). She started at UNLV in 1994 as a lecturer in food labs, eventually becoming director of the Culinary Arts Management program. After she obtained her Ph.D. in Educational Leadership from the university in 2006, she began working as an assistant professor in the College of Hotel Administration (now the College of

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Hospitality), becoming an associate professor in 2012. In 2015, Hertzman also became the College of Hotel Administration's Director of Enrollment Management.
