experiences growing up in early Las Vegas as well as information

on Las Vegas High School activities.

Scope and Contents

The collection is comprised of photographs, newspaper clippings, event programs, and personal ephemera collected by Dorothy Damrow Lee and Clark "Danny" Lee during their childhood and teenage years growing up in Las Vegas, Nevada during the 1940s and 1950s. The collection primarily focuses on Dorothy's high school experience attending Las Vegas High School and preforming in the Rhythmettes dance club at Las Vegas High. The collection also includes information about Danny's involvement with the creation of the Wildcat Lair at Las Vegas High School as well as his activities in the Boy Scouts. In addition to the information on their early lives,
