There are additional working prints included alongside the final prints for most of the scenes. Also included in the collection is one small photograph of Pratt. This collection

was formerly known as the Price Photograph Collection.

#### **Biographical Note**

Ernest Mitchell Pratt was born on April 24, 1876 in Salt Lake City, Utah. He was a commercial photographer and pictoralist in California. He also photographed the construction of the Hoover Dam (Boulder Dam) on the Arizona and Nevada border. Pratt died on August 23, 1945 in Los Angeles, California.
