Biographical Note

Ernest Mitchell Pratt was born on April 24, 1876 in Salt Lake City, Utah. He was a commercial photographer and pictorialist in California. He also photographed the construction of the Hoover Dam (Boulder Dam) on the Arizona and Nevada border. Pratt died on August 23, 1945 in Los Angeles, California.
