Historical Background

The UNLV Athletic Department first started in 1958, and the first sport to be organized was men's basketball team. Coach Michael Drakulich, known as "Chub," is considered to be the founding father of the athletics department at UNLV and coached the basketball, baseball, and golf teams. He later became the athletic director. It was not until a decade later that the football program was formed, and the women's tennis team formed in 1960. As of 2021, there are now sixteen sports programs including soccer, swimming and diving, baseball, cross country, golf, and volleyball.
